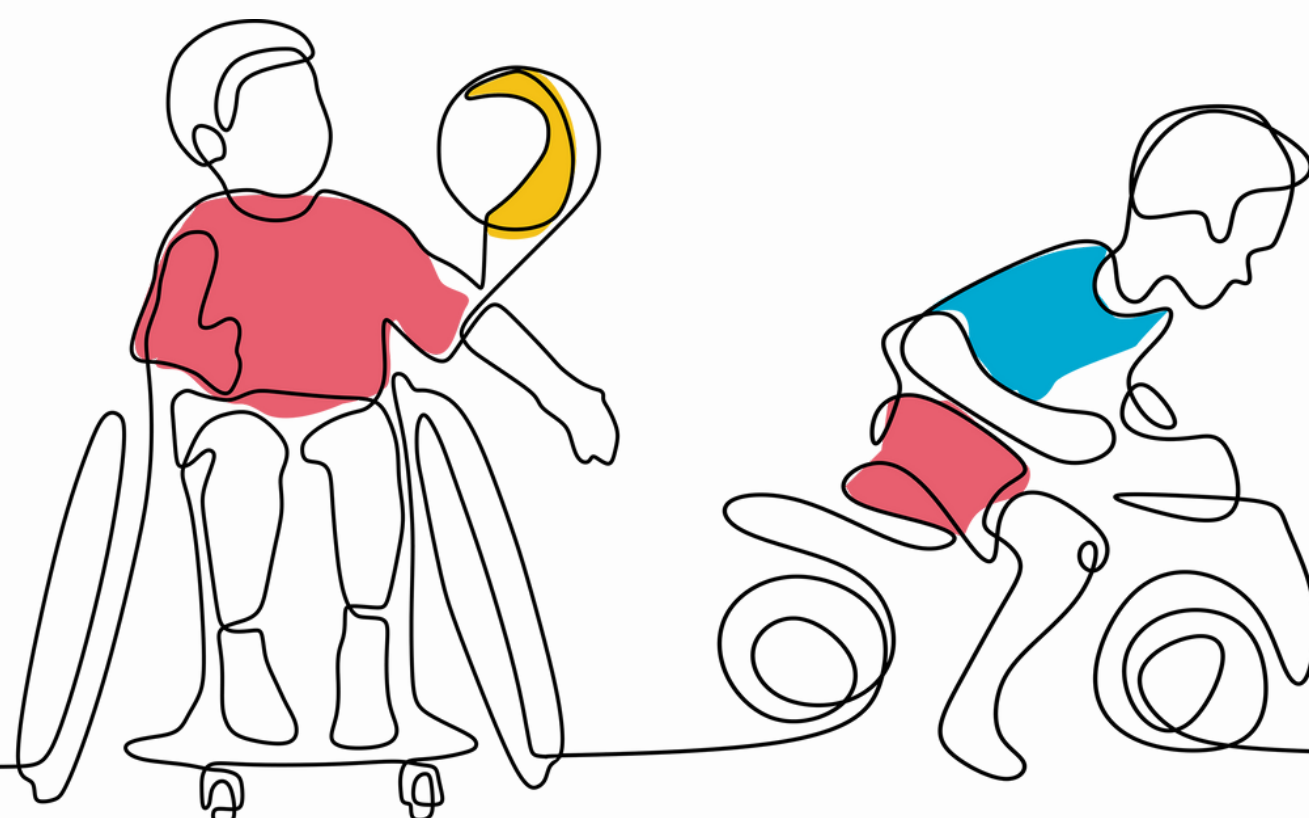


SEEKING CHILD AND YOUTH RESEARCH PARTICIPANTS: DO YOU HAVE A STORY TO TELL ABOUT LIVING WITH DISABILITY AND CHRONIC PAIN?



WHAT TO EXPECT IN THIS VIRTUAL STUDY:

- Child and youth participants will be guided through a **Body-Map Storytelling** exercise, and provided with materials to visually represent their experiences of chronic pain. The process may be done independently or with support from someone else
- Two online interviews will provide opportunities for participants to **reflect** on and **narrate** their experiences of chronic pain as illustrated through their body-maps

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE:

- 6-16 years of age
- Identify as living with disability or impairment
- Has received rehabilitation services related to disability
- Minimum one year living with chronic pain
- Resident of Canada
- Communicate in English
- Access to computer & internet
